

5 GOOD REASONS TO VOTE NO TO AV *on Thurs 5th May*

- 1** **It's unfair.** With First Past the Post (our current system), everybody gets one vote. But under AV, supporters of extreme parties like the BNP would get their vote counted many times, while other people's vote would only be counted once.
- 2** **It doesn't work.** Rather than the candidate with the most votes winning, under AV the person who finishes third could be elected.
- 3** **It's expensive.** Calculating the results would be a long, complicated process, which could even require special counting machines - and it would cost the taxpayer millions.
- 4** **It's discredited.** Only 3 countries in the world use AV - Fiji, Australia and Papua New Guinea - and both Fiji and Australia want to get rid of it.
- 5** **No-one wants it.** Even the 'Yes' campaigners don't want AV - they see it as a convenient stepping stone to even more reforms.
